The Personal Talent Skills Inventory is unique in its ability to assess an individual's cognitive structure, focusing on three dimensions of thought:

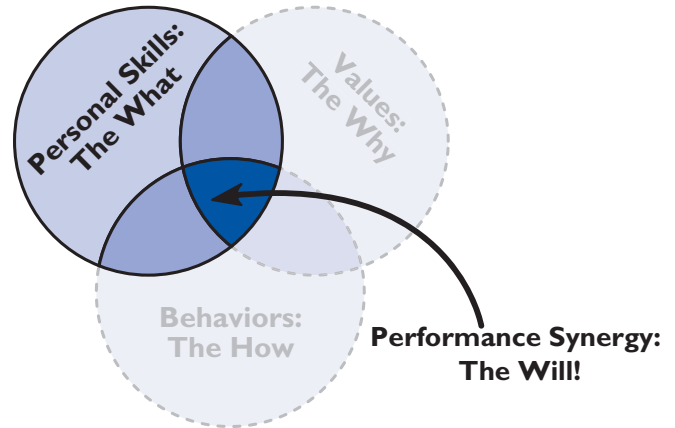
- **Systematic:** The dimension of ideas, thinking and structure. Systems judgment and self direction are measured.
